Important Information

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING USE AND MAINTENANCE OF FURNITURE WITH MINERAL COATING:

- The Mineral Coating might slightly change in colour and mellow over time as the basic material is real minerals. Surfaces of each item will vary in shade and structure. The surfaces are purposely dented, scratched and left rough; this completes the finish of the furniture and adds to the unique look of each individual item.
- Do not place any hot objects directly onto the surface without proper protection: always use mats and coasters with cork/felt backing underneath. Avoid mats and coasters with plastic/rubber as they can leave un-reversible marks on the surface.
- Never use sharp items on the surface of the product; knives and utensils may damage the surface. It is advisable to place a mat under paper when writing.
- Do not place your furniture next to a heat source such as a fire or radiator.
- Do not sit nor climb on your furniture.
- Do not use detergents, abrasive liquids or intensive cleaner as this will severely damage the surface.
- Clean up any liquid spilled onto the item using an absorbent cloth. PH neutral soap solution and water can be used to clean the surface. Please ensure the surface is left clean and dry. This should avoid any permanent stain. Never leave spilled liquids over a longer period of time. For example a wet vase base can still result in a stain when left too long.
